Keeping Healthy at Preschool



With the cold and flu season well under way we are reminding parents that children who appear even mildly ill should be kept at home. This is for their safety as well as the population of the school.

If your child is going to be out of school please call the school and inform us of the symptoms and when they began. We are tracking all children who are absent from school due to illness.

Children who arrive at school and begin to appear ill will be sent home immediately, even if a fever is not present.

If you are a working parent please make arrangements to be released from work early if your child becomes ill or arrange to have an alternate adult assigned to pick up your child. You may add new people to your child's Identification and Emergency Information form in the school office. Inform all alternates that their ID is required when they arrive to pick up your child at school.

Children must be free of all symptoms for a minimum of 24 hours before they will be allowed to return.



Following the rules

Teaching children right from wrong isn't easy. But setting and using effective rules helps them understand what behaviors you expect from them.

TRY these tips:

😊 Tell your child why a rule needs to be set. He'll be more likely to follow it. *Example:* "Wash your hands after you play outside, if you don't, there might be germs on your hands that could make you sick."

😊 Criticize the behavior, not the child. You may be tempted to say, "You are the messiest kid I've ever seen. I can't believe you did this." Instead, try, "Jimmy, I'm upset that there's mud all over the floor, please get the mop and clean up the mess."

😊 Once a rule is set, avoid applying consequences inconsistently. *For example,* when your child jumps on the bed, you respond by giving him a time-out one day and ignoring the behavior the next. The result: Your youngster won't understand that broken rules have consequences.

Editor's Note: Setting clear rules will help your child feel more secure and encourage self-discipline

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Fire Safety

More house fires happen in winter than any other time of year. To keep your youngster safe, teach him to:

- Stop, drop, and roll in case his clothes ever catch on fire.
- Crawl low to the ground in an emergency, since smoke and heat rise.
- Keep his bedroom door closed at night (to slow the spread of a fire).

To help your child feel comfortable around firefighters, take him to your local fire station. Call ahead to find a good time to visit—he may get to sit in a fire truck or even try on a firefighter's boots and jacket!


